— STRUCTURED LEARNING PATH

- **64 lessons across 8 levels**, from first steps to performance preparation

— FLEXIBLE PIANO INPUT

- Assigned activities appear directly in each learner's library
- Review submissions, completion, and per-student results

- A **keyboard heatmap** reveals notes with high error rates
- Separate performance patterns for left and right hand
- Detailed played-versus-expected notes, tempo, and timing
